At this last show that I was at things ran so much smoother and faster. They had the automatic draw and in the past I have accidentally been left out of the draw due to the secretary missing my name. Your program automatically puts this in and that saves the confusion of if everyone got in the draw or not. Something else that was really nice was that they had the draw posted
on the fence. I could look to see what number my teams were which was nice as my daughter and $I$ share the same horse. We knew who needed to be on the horse next. I had a printed receipt handed to me for my records. Usually when we are trying to pay out everyone else is trying to pay out at the same time so it is hard to pay attention to see if the figures the secretary tells you are correct. I was able to see exactly what $I$ rode in and the amount I owed or won. You guys are doing a great job with this and I just wanted to let you know that $I$ think it is a great program.
