The verdict is in and the decision is unanimous! Contestants, vendors, sponsors and the RSNC staff all agree that the 2010 RSNC National Finals was not only record breaking in size with 3,800 teams, but also the FUNNEST National Finals ever.
A 600 team increase from last year is proof positive that the sport is steam rolling forward. The attraction of new members is a beacon of light that many other equine disciplines aren't receiving and it is obvious RSNC isn't taking it for granted. That is exactly why they went overboard in making sure that the Finals wasn't just another event.
To start off, 3800 teams in six days converts to close to 5,000 runs when you add 2 nd, 3 rd and final rounds. So you do the math, that's about 830 runs each day. Astonishingly, there wasn't a day that went past 6:00 p.m. and several were complete before 5:00 p.m. This allowed both contestants and staff to relax and enjoy the evenings like never before.
Throughout the week in addition to the superb ranch sorting competition, there were so many other enjoyable activities scheduled that there was never a dull moment. Guy McLean, an Australian horseman gave spectacular demonstrations every day with four horses that acted as if they understood English. Aaron Ralston dedicated all week to providing cattle skill demonstrations and offering clinics and tips to help individual contestants. Dale Martin provided great insight on how he designed the Ranch Sorter Saddle and how a saddle should fit a horse. Also Tim Lynch, a multi World Champion Reiner and horseman offered a superb clinic on horsemanship.
The positive feed back from contestants about those clinics was tremendous.
Then came the fun stuff! Apple bobbing, sack races, cowboy races, team penning, flags, poles and barrel racing were all arena 4 activities each and every day that both kids and adults took advantage of while waiting for their turn to ranch sort. Once again RSNC is thinking out of the box and it is working quite well.
The evenings were filled with music around the campfire by Mickey and Betsy Plemmons,
hot dogs and s'mores, houseboat dinner rides on Lake Murray, and a band at 2 Frogs. A free Producers' dinner banquet with over 300 in attendance honored our great producers. This all was only made possible because the RSNC staff ran such a spectacular event and scheduled it in such a way that contestants had time to have fun. The new RSNC Ranch Sorting Software passed the optimum test with 3800 teams, 6 computers and those wonderful new arena monitors that allowed contestant to know what was happening in every arena all day long.
With lots of money on the line, both the Wednesday and Saturday night finals were full of anticipation and excitement. The two finals splitting the week helped a few who couldn't stay all week, but most were having too much fun to leave and decided to stay anyway.
Saturday night was the icing on the cake with a celebrity sort for Western Wishes with many world champion horsemen from other disciplines participating and having fun ranch sorting for the first time.
Then President Dave Wolfe entered through the back gates of the sorting pens on a Harley Davidson Hog to kick off the finals competition with 18 Reinsman saddles, 60 RSNC jackets and bags of money hanging from the ceilings to add adrenaline, pressure and excitement to a spectacular event.
There are no questions why RSNC continues to explode, and why next year will be even bigger! If you missed it this year, you should start planning now for some FUN, FRIENDLY, FAMILY COMPETITION at next year's RSNC National Finals!
