



# 2012 STATE EXTRAVAGANZA

## ONE CLASS...

## 6 SADDLES



- 1. You must be one of the 3 highest point riders attending from your state in your rating category to qualify. Each state can create up to 3 state teams.**
- 2. All highest point riders attending from a state will be your state team A. All 2nd highest point riders attending from a state will be your state team B. All 3rd highest point riders attending from a state will be your state team C.**
- 3. It is necessary to have attended five sanctioned shows to ride in the STATE EXTRAVAGANZA. (Except Beginner)**
- 4. The highest point Beginner, Rookie, Novice, Amateur, Open and Masters from each state will each ride twice with their five other state team members on their state team A.**
- 5. The 2nd highest point Beginner, Rookie, Novice, Amateur, Open and Masters from each state will each ride twice with their five other state team members on their state team B.**
- 6. The 3rd highest point Beginner, Rookie, Novice, Amateur, Open and Masters from each state will each ride twice with their five other state team members on their state team C.**
- 7. If you place in the top 3 positions in your state in 2 different categories (ex. Novice and Masters) you can ride on 2 different teams. (ex. Team A and Team C)  
If you are frozen in one rating category and place in the top 3 positions in both rating categories you can ride at either rating category but not both. (ex. 2<sup>nd</sup> place as a #2 Rookie and frozen and 3<sup>rd</sup> place as a #3 Novice. You can ride in the Rookie category or the Novice category but not both. Your rating will be a #3 and you will ride in the State Extravaganza with a #3 rating.**
- 8. If you are tied in the same position (ex. 1<sup>st</sup> place in both categories) then you will ride in the category that you earned the most points in. In the other category you will trade positions with the next person under you. Example; you are in 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Novice class with 89 points and 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Masters class with 50 points. You will ride on the 1<sup>st</sup> team, Team A, as a Novice. You will ride on the 2<sup>nd</sup> team, Team B, as a Masters. The second place person in the Masters class will ride with the 1<sup>st</sup> place team, Team A. Those 2 contestants will swap places.**
- 9. If you placed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> place position in 2 categories then you will trade places with the 2<sup>nd</sup> place person in the category that you earned the least amount of points in.**
- 10. Each state team of 6 will pick 3 teams from their 6 members for their first ride. They will also draw a partner from their 6 for their 2nd ride. The draw will be done by RSNC in the following manner:**
- 11. A team will be assigned to every scenario that the 6 rating categories can make. On Wednesday night 2 rating categories will be drawn out of a hat and that combination will be used for all state Extravaganza draw teams.**

12. *The Division will be an All Level Handicap.*
13. *If a high point member does not attend, the next highest point member who attends can ride.*
14. *If no member qualifies or attends in a rating category, then the highest attending member in the next rating category down is eligible.*
15. *If a Masters does not qualify or attend, any youth attending from that state can substitute.*
16. *If a State does not have enough attending members for a six person team then they can combine with other states in the same situation. However the rating categories must be enforced for the assembled team. Only the top 20 qualifiers (except Beginners) are eligible to combine with these other states and only if that state is not complete enough for a team.*
17. *Entry fees are \$50/entry with a required two ride limit. (Pick 1 Draw 1 from your 6 rider team)*
18. *Six saddles will be awarded one to each member of the winning team!*
19. *6 RSNC CSI Saddle Pads will be awarded to the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team.*
20. *6 Trophy Breast Collars will be awarded to the 3rd place state team.*
21. *The teams in the top 20 in the State Extravaganza All Levels Handicap Class will each receive 20 to 1 points respectively.*
22. *Those points will determine the top three states who will all ride again with the same partners as before with a clean slate.(three states equaling 18 teams to the finals)*
23. *Your first objective is to win 1st in your state. No state can win 2 sets of 6 prizes.*
24. *The teams in the top 18 in the Finals of the State Extravaganza will each receive 10 to 1 points respectively.*
25. *Tie breakers: Total # of cattle sorted is 1st and time on ties is second (for states in Top Eighteen).*
26. *You have to get a time to get points. Those points will determine the winning.....*
