Beginner Class- Open to any novice rider on a novice horse  
( go to [www.ranchsorting.com](http://www.ranchsorting.com)). \$20 per run with pick/draw  
partner. 50 % payback. Maximum of 5 runs. Belt buckles to  
Champion, Res. Champion and Runner Up Teams.

Rookie/Intermediate Class – Open to rookie riders on rookie  
horses. Rookie means some cattle working experience. (For  
example; a rookie rider on a cutting, cow horse or sorting  
horse is not legal, but that same rider on a roping horse is  
legal.) Other rules same as beginner. 4 buckle sets for Top  
Cowboy Church, Top 4-H/Youth Team, Top 40 Something  
Cowgirls Team, and Top Non-Division Team. Teams (both  
members same) must designate division when entering.

Rancher, Working Cowboy, Stockman Class – Open to any  
rider on any horse. Rules like beginner. \$25. per run.

Champions- CRSNC Trophy Spurs. \$1000. guaranteed added  
money in class.

Top Hispanic Team- Top team regardless of class entered in.  
Top Feedyard Cowboy - as in Hispanic cowboy class.

School Rider Pre Registration \$60.and complete form and in  
by December 5th. Preregistration forms is attached or is  
available at church www site. School limited to 60 riders on  
a first-registered- first-in basis. After limit reached, others  
\$25. to audit all 4 classes on foot. Other general auditor N/C.
