

Western Heritage 3 & Below:

#6 HC Class (3 cap on rider)

Western Heritage All Levels HC

Combined ratings will be a #18 rating or below

Western Heritage Masters #10 HC (65 & older)

Combined ratings must be a #10 rating or below

Contestants must be aged 65 or above as of December 31, 2019

#10 Handicap:

Combined ratings must be a #10 rating or below

#14 Ranch Hand:

Combined ratings must be a #14 rating or below

Can have 8 picks (4 sort & 4 gate)

Ranch Hand Class - one person must stay in the gate

Youth #8HC:

4 Cap on Rider, 12 years and under

Rated Youth:

Combined ratings must be a #18 rating or below

All Levels HC- riders must be 18 & under

Only #4 & under youth earn points

Youth Beginner (12 & Under):

Combined ratings must be a #10 rating or below

1 cap on sorter (Youth) - Adult gate (no charge for adult)

Youth contestants must be 12 or below as of January 1, 2019

#8 Handicap:

Combined ratings must be a #8 rating or below

Rookie #11 HC (2 cap on sorter):

Combined ratings must be a #11 rating or below

Sorter rating must be a #2 or below - #3 or above must stay in the gate

If both partners' ratings are #2 or below - they can sort normally (rotate)

#6 HC w/#4 inc:

Combined ratings must be a #6 rating or below

If a team is rated #4 or below, 50% of their entry will be placed in an incentive side pot for top incentive teams

Open Sort:

Combined ratings will be a #18 rating or below

No Handicap

5 floor - no contestant can enter rated #4 or below

Western Heritage Beginner RH #10 HC (1 cap on sorter):

***Will run with Western Heritage rules- (walk/trot/quiet)**

Combined ratings must be a #10 rating or below

Sorter rating must be a #1 - #2 and above must stay in the gate

Ranch Hand Class- one person must stay in the gate

*Gate horse can work the gate at any speed.

Graduated Rookie Sort:

Combined ratings must be a #6 rating or below

3 cap on rider- any #3 or below can participate

Only the Rookie and Graduated Rookie members will earn points toward the Rookie/Graduated Rookie Saddle.

All Levels HC:

Combined ratings will be a #18 rating or below

Masters #10 HC:

Combined ratings must be a #10 rating or below

Contestants must be aged 50 or above as of December 31, 2019

#18 3 Man / 2 Gate Sort:

Combined ratings must be a #18 rating or below

Arena is arranged with 2 arenas to sort within

All teams will be run in the Outdoor Covered Arena

Graduated Beginner #4 non-handicap class (2 cap on rider):

Only the Beginner or Graduated Beginner members will earn points toward the Beginner/Graduated Beginner Saddle.

#13 Mixed HC:

combined ratings must be a #13 rating or below

Combination of contestants -

Female/male

Female/youth (18 & Under)

Male/youth (18 & under)

Female/Masters (65 & older)

Male/Masters (65 & older)

Non-Pro Futurity HC:

A copy of the horse's papers must be submitted with entry form horses 4 & under as of January 1st, 2019

Riders rated 5 & under

#5 & under rated rider can hold the gate - \$50 to hold gate

Riders have to have ridden in 5 shows to ride in futurity

Ranch Hand Class

Open Futurity HC:

A copy of the horse's papers must be submitted with entry form
horses 4 & under as of January 1st, 2019
Any rated rider can participate
Anyone can hold the gate - \$50 to hold gate
Riders have to have ridden in 5 shows to ride in futurity
Ranch Hand Class

Non-Pro Maturity HC:

A copy of the horse's papers must be submitted with entry form

Riders rated 5 & under
Riders have to have ridden in 5 shows to ride in maturity
Normal sorting class - everyone charged a fee

Open-Maturity HC:

A copy of the horse's papers must be submitted with entry form

Any rated rider can participate
Riders have to have ridden in 5 shows to ride in maturity
Normal sorting class - everyone charged a fee

#11 Ranch Hand HC (4 Cap sorter):

Combined ratings must be a #11 rating or below
Can have 8 picks (4 sort & 4 gate if rated #4 or below)
Can only have 4 picks as the gate holder if rated #5 or above
Ranch Hand Class - one person must stay in the gate

Bareback/Bridleless Sort:

Combined ratings will be a #18 rating or below
Must ride either bareback or bridleless

Lucky Duck:

Any team first out of the money is automatically entered into the class. Also, individual riders will be randomly entered for being a good sportsman, for falling off of their horse, other unfortunate circumstances, or other random acts of kindness.

No entry fee - ride for 2 Ranch Sorter Pro Cutters
- automatically entered into class if one out of the money from Wednesday finals
