RULES:

CINCH RSNC Rules Apply: All Divisions are 5 ride limit. In all Divisions, pick 4 draw 1 or draw up to 5. If you pick 1 you must draw 1. \$3 sanctioning fee will be added to each ride/entry for sorting. 55% payback in divisions with \$35 entry fee and higher. 50% payback in divisions with \$30 or less entry fee. Announcements and postings at the event take precedence over all previously printed materials.

STALLS/RV:

- NO full RV Hookups, generators and dry camping are welcomed. There are some 110 electrical outlets available but those won't run A/C. One 30 amp is available if needed.
- Shavings \$10/bag on the honor system
- Main Cow Barn (14 available) \$25/night/horse (Plus shavings); 12x12 steel pens with dirt floors
- Stable (3 oversize stalls, 3 regular stalls and 6 runs available; these are closest to arena) automatic waterers, concrete floors, no mats (12 x12 oversize stall \$40/night/horse plus shavings OR 12x12 stalls \$30/night/horse (plus shavings); Runs are 12x30 or 24x30 with Covered area and automatic waterers \$40/night/horse
- Lower Cow Barns (12 available) \$20/night/horse (plus shavings); 12x12 steel pens with dirt floors; water/feed tubs provided
- Additional outdoor runs, paddocks or panel pens available as needed \$15/night/horse (must fill all others first)

Of course, it's always appreciated if stalls are picked during your stay and clean upon departure! Muck tubs and a gator with a manure spreader is available for use during the event.

HOUSING:

All Linens (towels/sheets) are provided for your stay, along with dishes/flatware/etc. Everything has been renovated/remodeled in recent years. Weekly rates available.

- 1903 2 Story House (sleeps 7) \$400/night (King, Queen, Twin beds upstairs; King bed in schoolhouse room, 4 bathrooms); coffee pot and coffee included and laundry in house; propane firepit, outdoor seating/kitchen area and large porches outside
- Bunkhouse (sleeps 6) \$125/night (2 bunkbeds, both Twin over Queen, 1 bathroom); fridge, microwave, coffee pot and coffee provided; propane fire pit and outdoor seating
- Cabin (sleeps 4) \$150/night (1 King; 1 Queen Hide-a-Bed; 1 bathroom); full kitchen, Keurig, propane firepit with outdoor seating
- Apartment in Cow Barn (sleeps 5) \$150/night (1 Queen, 1 bunkbed Twin over Queen; 1 bathroom); Keurig, additional hallway bathroom
