





POINTS WILL BE ADDED TO THAT FROM THE FOLLOWING QUALIFYING CLASSES TO DETERMINE THE TOP 10 WORLD CHAMPIONS IN EACH LISTED RATING CATEGORY.

AT THE FINALS, FOR CLASSES THAT ARE NOT COMPLETED REFORE SATURDAY NIGHT FINALS, POINTS WILL BE APPLIED BASED ON RIDER STANDINGS GOING INTO THE FINAL ROUND. THE RESULTS FROM SATURDAY NIGHT'S CLASSES WILL NOT BE USED TO DETERMINE PRIZES.

- MUST BE QUALIFIED TO RIDE AT THE WORLD FINALS MUST BE ONE OF THE TOP 3 RIDERS IN THE NATIONAL POINTS RACE IN YOUR RESPECTIVE STATE AND RATING DIVISION

A STATE CAN HAVE UP TO 3 TEAMS. TO DETERMINE TEAMS, THE HIGHEST PLACING RIDERS FROM EACH ELIGIBLE DIVISION WILL REPRESENT TEAM A. SECOND HIGHEST PLACING RIDERS WILL REPRESENT TEAM B. THIRD HIGHEST PLACING RIDERS WILL REPRESENT TEAM C

STATE EXTRAVAGANZA TEAMS ARE MADE UP FROM THE FOLLOWING DIVISIONS.

TIE BREAKER RULE FOR ELIGIBILITY

- # OF SHOWS ATTENDED
- MOST POINTS EARNED AT ANY ONE SHOW IN THE SEASON
- MASTERS RIDERS CAN QUALIFY TO COMPETE ON 2 DIFFERENT TEAMS IF: THEY ARE IN THE TOP 3 POSITION IN THEIR STATE IN THE MASTER AND **RATING DIVISION**
- IF A MASTERS RIDER IS TIED FOR 1ST OR 2ND THEY EXCHANGE
- POSITIONS WITH THE PERSON BELOW THEM IN THE MASTERS DIVISION. IF THEY TIED FOR 3RD THE RIDER WILL EXCHANGE PLACES ABOVE THEM IN THE MASTERS DIVISION.
- A TEAM WILL CONSIST OF 5 RIDERS WHO PICK THEIR TEAMS
- THE DIVISION WILL BE AN ALL-LEVEL HANDICAP.
- IF A HIGH POINT MEMBER DOES NOT ATTEND. THE NEXT HIGHEST POINT MEMBER WHO ATTENDS CAN RIDE.
- IF NO MEMBER QUALIFIES OR ATTENDS IN A RATING CATEGORY, THEN THE HIGHEST ATTENDING MEMBER IN THE NEXT RATING CATEGORY DOWN IS FLIGIBLE
- IF A MASTERS DOES NOT QUALIFY OR ATTEND, ANY YOUTH ATTENDING FROM THAT STATE CAN SUBSTITUTE.
- IF A STATE DOESN'T HAVE ENOUGH ATTENDING MEMBERS FOR A FIVE-PERSON TEAM, THEN THEY CAN COMBINE WITH OTHER STATES IN THE SAME SITUATION
- ENTRY FEES ARE \$70/ENTRY WITH A REQUIRED TWO-RIDE LIMIT.
- RSNC TROPHY SADDLES WILL BE AWARDED TO THE WINNING TEAMS
- AWARDS WILL ALSO BE GIVEN TO THE 2ND AND 3RD PLACE STATE TEAM.
- FIRST OBJECTIVE IS TO WIN 1ST PLACE OUT OF YOUR STATE'S TEAMS IN THE FIRST ROUND. NO STATE CAN HAVE 2 TEAMS IN THE FINAL ROUND
- THE TOP 3 STATE TEAMS WITH THE MOST CATTLE SORTED IN THE FASTEST OVERALL TIME IN THE STATE EXTRAVAGANZAS WILL ADVANCE TO THE FINALS
