2009 was nothing short of spectacular for RSNC! When it was all said and done, we had 269 SANCTIONED EVENTS. Already, in just the 1st 6 months since our 2009 Finals, we have reached an all time new record of 4000 RSNC MEMBERS! The fun we are having and the "invite a friend program" is working for all of us. It will only get better as the economy recovers and each of you continue to welcome your friends and neighbors to enjoy this great sport.

There are several new and exciting things that RSNC is announcing for the 2010 season that will make this year even better.

First, we now have RSNC Ranch Sorting Software available. This new software has taken a year to create and I could not be more excited! This software is made specifically for the rules and ratings of RSNC and will automatically calculate the handicaps, draws, top ten, and contestant financial reports. It will make life easier for producers and will speed up the reporting process tremendously. This, in turn, will bring more events to our sport and will support consistency in rules and ratings all across the country. This \$500 software program is being offered free to the first 100 producers who sanction events in 2010 so let us know if you or someone you know may want to start producing in your area.

With the introduction of the RSNC Ranch Sorting Software, we now have the capability to, more cost effectively, track results from all RSNC events. This opens the door for new programs to serve you, the contestant, even better.

We have 3 new programs for 2010 that are part of a 2010 "BRING IT TO YOU" campaign. It is all about bringing value to your memberships Starting January 1st we have point's race and competition. Finals in each state where RSNC will track State Points State Championship Awards

and sanctioning fees to the state level. launched a STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS This will conclude with a New Year's producers choose to participate. throughout the year and will supply for the state finals.

Secondly, we are happy to announce that we now have the capability to track dollars won on horses. This opens the door to recognize our ultimate favorite partners for their contribution to your success. Be sure to register your horse with your entry so you will always have a way to verify your horse's winnings. With this we will be recognizing the top money earning horse from each state and nationally. This horse tracking program that will be launched April 1st is only available for events where producers use the RSNC Software. Be sure to ask.

Hopefully by now you know the: what and when of the 2010 "BRING IT TO YOU" campaign but you may be asking how we are going to recognize both you and your horse for your accomplishments.

This leads us to the third program. We are initiating a RSNC "RANCH SORTING HALL OF FAME". The RSNC Hall of Fame will permanently list the winners in each of the 6 rating categories both at the State and National level. RSNC MEMBERS FORUM

RSNC Member: I have a question for you that I would like to get clarified.

Can a producer of an event make me ride as a #2 if RSNC has me at a #1? I was recently at a show where the producer moved both my wife and I to a #2 for his shows which in my opinion hurt us in the sort for the saddle series. However, if I was able to ride as a #1, I could have possibly won a check and more points in the beginner ranch hand. Even if we were moved to rookies after winning another check, we would have at least had a chance at some more points for the rookie status as well. I guess I am confused as to how he can make us ride as a #2 and RSNC still has us as a #1. If indeed he is able to do that to us, shouldn't he have to tell RSNC that he moved us up in the number system? I don't see anywhere in the rules where a producer can change anyone's number. It states that they are heavily relied upon to keep the accuracy, but shouldn't RSNC be contacted and notified and there be some sort of an agreement prior to anyone be changed? This just doesn't seem fair to me.

Thanks for your help on this, it is greatly appreciated.

Dave Wolfe: Thank you for your question concerning your rating.

I will try to clarify our rating system and approach to the #1 rating. Until RSNC switched over to a 9 point rating system, all number 1,2 and 3 rated contestants were all riding together as a #1. When we went to a 9 point we initially moved all #1s that had won \$1000 in sorting or penning up to a #3 and all #1s that had won 3 checks in sorting or penning up to a number 2. This left all brand new number ones that hadn't won 3 checks as a true beginner. That opened the door for new contestants to our sport and it has worked great. The rest of the definition of a number one is a novice rider on a novice horse. Essentially, a #1 is someone who hasn't had cattle working experience and is even unsecure with simply riding horses. We have given full authority to RSNC producers to be absolutely sure that the #1 entry level stays exactly that way. Even if a contestant starts as a #1 and they go practice and take lessons before their 3 checks have been won, it is likely that they may get bumped to a #2.

I agree that it may cause problems for you with points as a number one and we sometimes question if we should even offer points and prizes at that level just because so many get moved. But truthfully the prize at the number one level is supposed to be for those that have never and may never win again. Everyone else who has some hope still gets to carry points that they win as a number one to a number 2 category and continue adding to them. In addition, because of this exact situation, all graduated number ones such as yourself, will get to compete in the graduated beginner division at the National finals. We created that class just for 1st year contestants who have won 3 checks or showed enough

improvement to warrant the move. With 8 more levels above the number one rating all contestants still have great opportunities to succeed.

So to answer your question in a nut shell, RSNC requires producers to use the probationary rating time period to move contestants to not only keep the number one rating squeaky clean, but all contestants that may be under or over rated in their 1st year should be constantly evaluated by producers to keep the contests as fair as possible. After that the win loss ratios will dictate who gets moved and who doesn't. A contestant should never think he or she is always a number one until he or she has won three checks.

RSNC Member: Thanks for your response, it was greatly appreciated. I don't think that it's a bad thing that the producers have the authority to move an individual as they see fit. However, I think there needs to be a time line, as in other horse related sports, where the individual is told either through writing or an e-mail from RSNC (not a producer) that he/she's rating is being evaluated or changed.

I'm not denying that I fit the #2 rating as opposed to the #1, but it's quite a shock to arrive at a show expecting one thing and then get hit with the news that your number has been changed. I also think that there should be some guidelines set for first time competitors. I think that recruitment for the sport is important and we don't want new comers to get discouraged. However, when you have cutting horse people and ropers show up and they are given a #1 rating, and then out ride and out sort higher number sorters it isn't fair and it discourages the true #1 rated sorters. There needs to be a line drawn in the sand that says you are a #1 or #2 based on previous experience. I also understand that not everyone can be numbered correctly on the spot at all times, but when they come in saying they are team ropers and cutting horse people, they should automatically be given at the minimum a #2 rating based on experience.

I don't want you to think that I am complaining, I just think that the system needs some fine tuning and I would like to give my two cents worth. I will get off of my soapbox now and let you get back to more important things. Thanks for taking the time to listen to my concerns.

Dave Wolfe: I agree totally with all that you said and I will continue to relay that on to all producers. I am actually going to remove all names from our conversation and add this to the Member's Forum of our next ranch sorter. As always I don't discuss names of contestants with producers. Thanks for your input.

RSNC Member: Thank you for listening. This is a great sport and I will do whatever it takes to help it succeed.

Hill: They r also starting a state points race for right here at home. Now I would never think of not makin their finals but just incase we couldn't RSNC is trackin points from Jan to Thru Dec and they will even put up buckles and prizes if our producers wants a state finals!

Billy: That down right hospitable. This way we get to go for 2 races. One from June to July for the National finals and the big bucks and saddles and stuff and the other from Jan thru Dec for the state race with Buckels and stuff.

Hill: I cant believe that soaked into your thick skull that fast. I figured I would have to draw you a picture.

Billy: What else to they got up their sleeve?

Hill: Starting April 1st, they will be tracking dollars on our donkeys. Every producer who uses the new software can now enter our horses name and they will start acululatin a winning record.

Billy: Now there talking. I been wishin fur that fur years. Now when I tell you ol dobbin won \$!000000000 you just might believe me!

Hill: You aint gona believe this last one!

Billy: Whats dat

Hill: We just might some day be in a Hall of Fame! They are starting a Ranch Sortin Hall of Fame where the top riders from each state and the top riders at the National finals will perminately be put in the RSNC Hall of Fame.

Billy: Wow! Now that bout made me swaller my chew! I never... I NEVER.. I NEVER.





With the recent announcement of the 2010 RSNC Finals location being moved to Ardmore, Oklahoma June 27 -July 3rd, the response has been 100% positive. a multi-million dollar renovation that will make our National Finals even more spectacular!

one of the outdoor covered arenas. But there is more! They have now completed a third covered arena. In addition to that all 3 arenas are attached, so if the summer monsoons hit, no one will have

RSNC IS 'BRINGING IT TO YOU' IN 2010

We at RSNC are constantly looking at opportunities to serve our producers and members better. One concern heard numerous times throughout the year is "what can we do for those contestants who don't get attend our National Finals and take a bite out of that huge orange carrot?"

In addition to a complete set of standardized rules to follow, a fair and accurate national rating system, collecting and processing all of the data to provide a National Points race, the National Finals is a huge part of what your \$3 sanctioning fee goes toward.

We have purposely left the qualification open so every member can participate at some level because this is where we want everyone to come together to celebrate the sport. It is our signature event and our signal to the equine industry that our sport is truly exploding.

With that said, we readily realize that there are numerous reasons beyond our control that prohibit some members from attending. The cost of travel and financial restraints is definitely not the least. Therefore, those contestants don't get to take the full advantage of their membership and sanctioning contributions. That is why RSNC is starting the 2010 "Bringing It To You" campaign. We still want you to shoot for the National Finals in June but in addition to that, we are now going to make a huge commitment to our

producers and each of you by bringing prizes to the state level!

Starting January 1st 2010 all RSNC contestants will have the opportunity to compete in a state point's race and a State Finals on the following New Year's weekend. Producers from your state, starting with the producer that submitted the most sanctioned teams, will be offered the opportunity to host a New Years Finals and if they do, RSNC will help furnish awards! For every state that sanctions at least 5 shows in 2010, RSNC will contribute 6 Trophy Buckles. For every state that sanctions 10 or more shows RSNC will contribute prizes thru 5th place in addition to the 6 Trophy buckles! This "Bringing it to You" promotion replaces the Producer Stirrups Series.

This sport is to fun to keep a secret so we are also going to allow county and state fairs to sanction RSNC events and they can count as 2 qualifying shows for this point's race. Please contact your county fair and help them help all of us by introducing your community to this great sport with a county or state fair RSNC sorting. We are making the RSNC software available free to the fair producers for these events.

The points system will be identical to the current RSNC National Finals point's race. First place contestants will earn

½ point for 3 to 4 teams, 1 point for 5 to 9 teams, 2 for 10 to 14 teams, 3 for 15 to 19, 4 for 20 to 24, 5 for 25 to 29, 6 for 30 to 34, 7 for 35 to 39, 8 for 40 to 44, 9 for 45 and over up to 100 and then double. Anyone can attend the state finals but the top 20 in each rating category from each state will enter the State Finals with 20 to 1 points respectively to add to points earned at the New Years Weekend State Finals.

Now for the big news!

RSNC is initiating a **RSNC HALL OF FAME**.

At the state level, each winning member from each rating category from each state will permanently be listed in the RSNC HALL OF FAME! The state high money winner and the high money horse from each state will additionally be enshrined into the RSNC HALL OF FAME. We all want to get more bang for our buck and I believe this type of recognition will be a tremendous asset with a feather in our caps, so to speak, for our accomplishments! This could not be done without the introduction of the RSNC software. In fact, the Horse tracking that will be launched April 1st 2010 will only be available to contestants where the producers are using the software so be sure to ask your producer if the horse tracking option is available.

Don't miss this opportunity to be the first to be permanently recognized for your ranch sorting success!






