RANCH SORTING TO BE FEATURED ON TWO PROGRAMS ON RFD-TV

WIDE WORLD OF HORSES AND THE RIDE

Wide World of Horses, the most watched equine program on RFD-TV, will air the 2010 Ranch Sorting National Championships National Finals the week of September 6th, 2010.

More than 3,800 teams competed at the RSNC National Finals, which were June 28-July 3 at the Hardy Murphy Coliseum in Ardmore, Oklahoma and *Wide World of Horses* was there to capture all of the excitement of the highly competitive finals as well as the Celebrity Sort.

The celebrity sort was put together by Aaron Ralston. Aaron is an exceptional horseman who has his own TV series on RFD-TV called *The Ride*. The benefit for the celebrity sort was Western Wishes, which is an organization dedicated to granting "cowboy wishes" to children with cancer. Young Brian Wilson was our guest and he was able to meet and shake hands with all of the celebrities. Aaron attracted many top horsemen from other disciplines to ranch sort and calculate their teams so the proceeds could go to Western Wishes. They included Dick Pieper, Jim Babcock, JW Hart, Robert Chown, Rusty Dare, Jeff Petska, Kurt Crawford, Gerold Cosby, Benton Bland, Shawn Hayes and more comprising many world championship titles from the group of great horseman with big hearts. It was a great event and even greater cause.

Furthermore Aaron has teamed up with RSNC to help spread the word about our exciting sport. Both Aaron and RSNC President Dave Wolfe developed a Ranch Sorting DVD on fundamentals of Ranch Sorting. The DVD is available on the RSNC web site but most exciting is that Aaron will be airing a two part series on "The Ride" with excerpts from this DVD and the National Finals. That series will air on September 6th and 13th at 12pm and 10 pm central time. If you can't catch it on those days it will also air again on September 12th and 19th at 11:30 pm central time.

Rating changes

At a recent RSNC event several contestants were caught by surprise that their rating was moved from a #1 to a #2 or from a #2 to a #3. They indicated they had not received a letter informing them that their rating was changed and that they had already put together teams and then had to change them at the last minute. We all realize the difficult situation this creates and for that we apologize. Oddly enough, this is a result of our efforts to be more efficient. The new RSNC software automatically downloads results

into the office software which includes dollars won and dollars spent. It then automatically moves #1 and #2 contestants based on the limit rules. Therefore, when our producers request the membership and rating database the very next weekend, the ratings of some contestants have automatically been moved. However, to physically process those individuals who have been moved up in the database and to send them a letter takes time, especially here at the beginning of the year when we have both new membership and membership renewals.

Therefore, we want to make all #1 and #2 rated contestants aware that this may happen to them. Most know if they have exceeded the limit of three checks for a #1 or \$1,000 for a #2 so they should prepare themselves to be moved by calling the office or asking at the show before they enter. It is unfair to other contestants if you have exceeded the limit and continue to ride at the lower rating just because you didn't receive a letter in the mail.



CHEYENNE FRONTIER DAYS RSNC SUMMER SPECTACULAR

1436 TEAMS COMPETE AT 'THE DADDY OF 'EM ALL'

The 10th Annual Big Daddy Summer Spectacular stood up to its name as a spectacular success! 1436 teams competed with contestants from 11 states attending. Some came from as far away as Minnesota, Wisconsin and even Georgia to take part in the Ranch Sorting competition. Cheyenne Frontier Days hosting the Worlds Largest Outdoor Rodeo is a huge attraction for contestants because they get to mingle through out this truly western town with all the top cowboys in the world. The saloons are buzzing with rodeo contestants and all the stories that are attached. It is a modern taste of the western frontier and a great excuse to "go west young man".

The competition started on Thursday July 29 at the Laramie County Community College indoor arena. Both a double and single sort pens were set up so the event would move fast and contestants could enjoy their evenings in town if they chose to do so. The All Levels Handicap was first out of the gate with two Colorado Cowboys Ken Coulson and Dwayne Haselip taking 1st place



away from 84 teams and a check for \$1109. Then we moved on to a number 4 division with exactly 100 teams entered. Ben Bacca and Stephanie Ewoldt, team mates in more ways than one, took top honors with a check for \$1320. However since this was Ben's 1st buckle ever, he was most excited about that. The Cheyenne Frontier Days buckle is a favorite for most cowboys all over the world and Ben wins it as his very first! How great is that! The next class up is the #14 Ranch Hand with 90 teams entered. Rich Smidt and Dwayne Haselip sorted 22 head in 163. 71 seconds for

pens. This is truly a great example of gate sorting in corrals at branding time where you sort in and out or right and left all day long. 40 teams jumped on board to try it out and almost all of them said they truly loved the class. The Wolfe boys along with rancher Alan Kirkbride sorted 9 head in 86.62 for 1st place. As you can see this class makes you slow down to succeed!

The sorting finished up at 5:30 on Thursday. Some contestants went to concerts, others went to the saloons and some stayed to enjoy the evening in the outdoor arena with a little team

\$1188. They started strong with 10 head and fast time on their 1st go and kept the lead to win the buckles and the big checks. Next was the Youth #4 cap on the sorter. 24 teams entered and Katie Ranucci drew up with Andrew Lebrecht for a \$500 win. I think Andrew's new horse is already paying off. The last sorting class of the day was the new 3 Man Olympic Sort. In this class 3 of the 4 rings in a double sort pen are used. 2 gate openings are made with a gate man in each. 3 contestants take turns sorting cattle out of the middle sort pen into the opposite right and left

penning fun.

Jim Kinnison, Mike Hansen and Stephanie Ewoldt won the Pro Am Novice Penning and Ken Coulson, Kelly Bernhardson and Nicole Shanks won the Novice Penning.

Friday started of at 8:30 sharp with the National Anthem and the number 10 Handicap. Local Cheyenne cowgirl Norweta Fox and Kason Wolfe beat out 167 teams for a \$1816 check and Norweta's first Ranch Sorting buckle. Once again

the money will come and go but that buckle will be a great reminder of a very fun day in Cheyenne. This year because of so many new beginners attending we teamed beginners up with beginners for the beginner sort and we still had 104 teams! That would have been over 200 teams if it would have been a Ranch Hand class! Oklahoma contestants Bryce Stallcup and Lisa White also won their first ranch sorting buckles and a big check. This class was sponsored by Aztec fencing who has agreed to sponsor the Wolfe Production beginner classes with buckles at each event for the upcoming year! If you need any fencing done be sure to look them up on the RSNC web site. Then comes the Masters. They are to be reckoned with and they came in force with 113 teams. Oklahoma cowboys DeRoy White and Larry Newport were victorious as masters of all masters this year at Cheyenne. They won over \$1400 and buckles. The last sorting class on Saturday was the fun Sadie Hawkins where girls ask guys and change their minds true to form and go the other way. Julie Weeks and Kason Wolfe teamed up and got er done with 79 teams to beat for a \$1043 check.

Six o'clock was quitting time for many, party time for others and team penning time for some. After a nice rain shower the arena was perfect and the temperature made you look for a jacket that you hadn't worn since early spring. David Horn and the Wolfe boys got wild and crazy in the bareback sort to win almost \$500. Then Lisa and David Horn and Dave Wolfe won the black Jack penning with 26 teams for an \$819 check. Lots of fun on a cool evening in Cheyenne.

Saturday posted temperatures in the high 40's in the early morning hours so cattle and horses were fresh! The #13 Handicap was 1st with 86 teams competing. Draw team Kevin Speer and David Horn sorted 28 head to beat all comers for \$1335. New contestants meet and succeed with draw partners everywhere we go and this was no exception. The #11 Rookie Handicap had 125 teams and Jeff Chism from Wisconsin drew up with Cheree Lebrecht to make new friends and win a big check. The Beginner Youth had 26 brand new sorters compete with an adult working the gate for them. Melissa Warner from Nebraska was

extremely excited to win that class. After that was the #11 Ranch Hand (4 cap on the sorter) Claudia Hershey and Logan Wolfe grabbed the honors there and a check for \$1317. Then Claudia Hershey turned right around in the #6 and won it with Suzy Karlinski. Congratulations ladies and especially Suzy who never said never and jumped up this time to win a big one for nearly \$1500!!!

Once again the sorting was wrapped up before 7 pm and the diehards went outside to team pen. The Pro Am had 11 teams

ceremonies as the RSNC Champions in front of a packed grand stands of 25,000 spectators. It doesn't get much better than that!!



2010 State Championship Point Standings

RSNC STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

With the end of the year fast approaching, so is the RSNC State Championships Points Race. This contest started January 1st, 2010 and will end on New Year's weekend 2011. The purpose of the State Championships is to award contestants at the state level for competing within RSNC sanctioned events. This year RSNC will provide 6 RSNC Championship jackets to the high point #1, #2, #3 & 4, #5 & 6, #7 & above and Masters contestants if there were a minimum of 5 sanctioned events within the state. If there were 10 or more sanctioned events within the state, RSNC will provide jackets to the Top 5 contestants in each rating category making 30 jackets in all.

Contestants earn points throughout the year

and will enter the Finals in 1st through 20th place with 20 to 1 points respectively. Anyone can compete at the Finals but only those entering in the top 20 of their rating category are eligible for the RSNC Trophy Jackets. Each producer will be sent jackets of various sizes and the winning contestants will be sent the correct size once selected. Below is the list of current Producers from each qualifying state who had the most sanctioned teams during the 2009/2010 season.


