LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

“Time flies when you’re having fun!”

Not sure who was the first to say that but they couldn’t be more right. It seemed like yesterday when we had just finished up last year’s record-breaking National Finals and here we are sending out the last issue before this year’s National Finals.

Fun seems to be a common thread that we all are in hot pursuit of and I am thrilled that so many are finding it at RSNC Ranch Sorting events. A lot of the credit has to go to all of the great RSNC producers who have found a way to provide quality events.

A well produced event that gives contestants assurance that they have a fair shot within the competition is a key ingredient. Another key ingredient is an event that runs in a timely fashion. Producers that are efficient in entry preparation, class draws and running of classes will always have a steady stream of contestants. It isn’t always as easy as it seems from the outside looking in. As contestants, if you have never produced an event then you probably don’t have a true appreciation of what your producers go through to provide you the opportunity to compete and have fun. At your next event be sure to tell your producer how much you appreciate their efforts. It goes a long way when they are numbering cattle in a rain storm or paying the cattle bill, etc...

We, here at the RSNC office, have just completed our tour of the US with the production of four Regional Super Sorts. We know what is involved in producing events and all the preparation, planning and execution that has to happen to make it work. But boy is it fun when it does. I am ecstatic about the overall response of our first year of Regional Super Sorts. My goal was to host four quality events that would reward our membership closer to home and give everyone a taste of what they could expect if they travel to the National Finals. I made a point to bring a core group of our National Finals staff so we could not only reward the membership but also so we could reward the producers by not making them do all the work. Lastly, my ultimate hope was that we could average 1,000 teams for the four events so the four arena concept would be utilized. Every goal was not only reached but exceeded and there were a total of 4,011 teams making the average 1,003 teams at each. It is my hope that we have encouraged many of you to attend the National Finals in July and with your help we can showcase our sport to the World.

In visiting with producers from all across the United States at each of the Regional events, it has been decided that at each State Finals points will not be adjusted. They have listened to you, the membership, and I in turn am listening to them, therefore that rule will be put in place immediately. The State points race will continue just as planned, but at the end of the year the top 20 will have their points earned from the State Finals event added to all of the points they have earned throughout the year to determine the State Champions. This does not affect or change the National Points rules and race.

Be sure to check out all of the results and articles in this issue and especially the ones on page 28. The 1st covers details about the finals and the 2nd is ABSOLUTELY ASTOUNDING!!!







Folks I am here to tell you, a little elbow grease goes a long way. We have all heard it before and we all need to practice it more. This is the 3rd year in a row that we here in Colorado have practiced what we preached and have had tremendous success doing it.

Each spring we start a new membership drive by asking each member to go find a new member to participate in a RSNC sanctioned event. We help them by putting ads in the local papers, fliers in the feed stores and gas stations and where ever rural folks may gather. We also set up a booth at the Colorado Horse Expo and hand out literature about the sport and upcoming clinics and events.

CINCH RSNC NORTH CENTRAL REGIONAL SUPER SORT



Hey Ranch Sorters! ~ Its time to cowboy up!!

That's right the sport of ranch sorting has a very unique opportunity to break into the professional rodeo circuit right along with all of the other great rodeo events. This year right out of the box Mr. Cotton Rosser, the patriarch of rodeo, has invited us to participate in some of his most prestigious rodeos along the west coast.

Just think what this could do for our sport. Instead of thousands of fans setting in the stands knowing they could never participate in the rodeo action they now can watch Ranch Sorting and think that this is an event that they could actually go home get on their horse and participate in.

With levels for beginners to the most advanced our sport offers exactly what the entire equine community is looking for. Ranch Sorting is a fun competitive and challenging western heritage event that, with your help, will be showcased in the Rodeo Arenas this summer and fall!

That is a huge bonus jack pot and it will determine the Champions of the show.

Then both 1st and 2nd place Champions in both Round Robins will be invited to the Circuit Finals at the Cow Palace to ride in their respective Round Robin category for free against the 1st and 2nd place Champions from the other circuit shows. The over all winner 3 and below and the over all winner 4 and above will each be awarded a Todd Jeys custom Trophy Saddle for the Cotton Rosser/ PRCA Ranch Sorting Circuit Championship that will be presented by Mr. Rosser himself.

This will make these events and awards as prestigious as they come and one the winners will cherish for a life time. It may also just be the start of a phenomenal explosion of one of the greatest events in the Rodeo industry.




